To maintain the integrity of our course and ensure a respectful atmosphere, it is important that all Members and Guests, including children, adhere to the dress code. Acceptable golf attire typically mirrors the styles found in the Golf Shop and those worn by **PGA** and **LPGA** professionals.

We kindly ask that Members take responsibility for introducing or accompanying Guests to ensure they are dressed in appropriate attire throughout all areas of the property.

## **Men**

- Shirts – collared golf shirts are acceptable. Crew neck shirts and t-shirts are not permitted on the golf course.
- Pants/Shorts – jeans or pants/shorts with fading or tattered look are not acceptable attire, nor are rugby pants, sweatpants, or jogging pants.
- Shoes – only soft spike shoes may be worn on the golf course. Golf shoes with metal-spikes of any kind are not permitted.

## **Women**

- Tops – tailored blouse and golf shirts are encouraged. Tube tops, crop tops and tank tops are not permitted.
- Pants – sweatpants, jogging pants, stirrup pants, low-rise pants or shorts with drawstrings are not acceptable attire.
- Shoes – only soft spike shoes may be worn on the golf course. Golf shoes with metal-spikes of any kind are not permitted.

## **Muskoka Room**

We kindly ask that all guests adhere to the following guidelines to ensure a comfortable and enjoyable dining experience for everyone:

- **Attire:** Please dress in a manner that reflects respect for the occasion. Smart casual attire is recommended. While formal wear is not required, we ask that you avoid overly casual clothing such as athletic wear, shorts, or beach wear.
- **Footwear:** Proper footwear is expected. Please refrain from wearing flip-flops, slippers, or excessively casual shoes.
- **Grooming:** We encourage all guests to maintain personal grooming standards that contribute to a pleasant atmosphere. Clean and tidy appearance is appreciated.
